Dear Parent/Guardian:

This notice is to inform you that RINGWORM has been diagnosed in a child at this Head Start Center. This condition is contagious; therefore, we would like you to watch for symptoms in your child. The symptoms are as follows:

SKIN – DRY, SCALY RING-SHAPED PATCHES THAT ITCH.

FEET - CRACKING, PEELING OF SKIN BETWEEN TOES.

SCALP - SCALING OF SCALP WITH BROKEN HAIRS OR PATCHES OF HAIR LOSS.

If your child should develop one or more of these symptoms, please notify your child's health care provider and your child's teacher. Medical treatment should be carried out as recommended by your child's medical health care provider. A child diagnosed with Ringworm can return to the classroom after 24 hours of medical treatment has been completed. We are attempting to limit the spread of this illness/condition, and your cooperation is sincerely appreciated.
