



UMATILLA-MORROW HEAD START, INC. WOMEN, INFANTS, AND CHILDREN (W.I.C.) FACT SHEET



This special nutrition education and supplemental food program provides services to help improve the health of its participating women, infants, and children and to optimize their future health by developing healthy eating habits.

WHO CAN BE ON THE WIC PROGRAM?

- ❖ Women who are pregnant or breastfeeding.
- ❖ Women who have delivered within the last six months.
- ❖ Infants and children from birth to five years of age.

WHAT ARE THE QUALIFICATIONS?

- ❖ An income within the WIC income guidelines – 185% of the federal poverty rate.
- ❖ Being a resident of Umatilla, Morrow, Gilliam or Wheeler Counties.
- ❖ Proof of income, identity, and residency must be provided when you are screened for eligibility for WIC services.
- ❖ A nutritional or medical risk which will be reevaluated every six months.

WHAT SERVICES ARE PROVIDED?

- ❖ Screen for anemia, poor growth patterns, inadequate diet and other health problems and needs.
- ❖ Nutrition counseling and education that relates good nutrition to health and dietary habits.
- ❖ Nutritious foods to improve nutrition related medical problems.
- ❖ Referral to other health or social services when needs are identified.
